of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, to establish an Alabama Lottery; to establish an Alabama Lottery Corporation; to establish the Lottery Trust Fund, provide for its allocation for education and general fund programs; to authorize the Legislature to implement the amendment through enabling legislation; and to terminate the lottery and the Alabama Lottery Corporation after a specified period of time.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 65 of Article IV of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 65.

22 "Part I.

"The legislature Except as provided in Part II of
this section, the Legislature shall have no power to authorize
lotteries or gift enterprises for any purposes, and shall pass
laws to prohibit the sale in this state of lottery or gift
enterprise tickets, or tickets in any scheme in the nature of

1	a lottery; and all acts, or parts of acts heretofore passed by		
2	the legislature <u>Legislature</u> of this state, authorizing a		
3	lottery or lotteries, and all acts amendatory thereof, or		
4	supplemental thereto, are hereby avoided.		
5	"Part II.		
6	"(a) The Legislature shall provide for the		
7	establishment and regulation of an Alabama Lottery.		
8	"(b) Funds deposited into the Education Trust Fund		
9	pursuant to subsection (e) may not be used in any manner to		
10	replace or supplant existing or any other funds dedicated or		
11	intended for education.		
12	"(c) The net proceeds from the Alabama Lottery shall		
13	be deposited and held in a special, separate account in the		
14	State Treasury to be known as the Lottery Trust Fund until		
15	such time as the fund is allocated pursuant to this section.		
16	"(d) The administration of the Alabama Lottery shall		
17	be vested in a corporation, to be known as the Alabama Lottery		
18	Corporation which is hereby created. The duties, powers,		
19	authority, and composition of the Alabama Lottery Corporation		
20	shall be provided by general law.		
21	"(e) Monies in the Lottery Trust Fund shall be		
22	allocated as follows: Forty percent shall be deposited into		
23	the state General Fund, 40 percent shall be deposited into the		
24	Education Trust Fund, and 20 percent is appropriated to the		

Alabama Department of Corrections.

1	"(f) The Alabama Lottery Corporation may enter into
2	reciprocal agreements with other jurisdictions for the
3	operation and promotion of a lottery or lotteries.
4	"(g) All interest earnings on monies in the Lottery
5	Trust Fund shall be held in the fund and allocated only for
6	those items enumerated in subsection (e).
7	"(h) The Legislature may enforce and implement this
8	section by appropriate general law. The Legislature may
9	establish definitions to effectuate the implementation of this
10	<pre>amendment.</pre>
11	"(i) Nothing in this section affects any activity
12	which was legal at the time the amendment to this section
13	becomes effective.
14	"(j) The lottery and the Alabama Lottery Corporation
15	created and functioning pursuant to this amendment and any
16	enabling legislation authorized by this amendment shall
17	terminate on December 31 of the tenth year following the date
18	of ratification of this amendment. If this amendment is
19	ratified, the Alabama Lottery Commission shall begin winding
20	down lottery operations on January 1 of the tenth year
21	following the date of the ratification of this amendment."
22	Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
23	shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the
24	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284
25	and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
26	Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
27	state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 1 2 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 3 following description of the substance or subject matter of 4 5 the proposed constitutional amendment: "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 6 7 Alabama of 1901, to establish an Alabama Lottery; to create an Alabama Lottery Corporation to regulate and administer the 8 lottery; to allocate the proceeds to the state General Fund, 9 10 the Education Trust Fund, and the Department of Corrections; to allow the Legislature to implement the Alabama Lottery 11 through appropriate general law; and to terminate the lottery 12 13 and the Alabama Lottery Corporation after a specified period of time." 14 15 "Proposed by Act ." 16 This description shall be followed by the following 17 language: "Yes () No ()." 18
