a 2/3 vote unless: it comes within a number of 1 2 specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates 3 funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to 4 5 the entity for the purpose. The purpose or effect of this bill would be 6 7 to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person
to pay or offer to pay an individual to assist in completing,
obtaining, or delivering another voter's absentee ballot.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to accept
payment from another person for assisting in completing,
obtaining, or delivering another voter's absentee ballot.

10 (c) Any individual who violates this section shall11 be guilty of a Class D felony.

12 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its 13 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 14 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further 15 requirements and application under Amendment 621, as amended 16 by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 17 18 as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime. 19

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
