(b) (1) The costs shall be collected as other costs 1 2 in cases are assessed and collected by the clerk of the court and shall be paid by the clerk to the Mobile County 3 Commission. The county commission, in consultation with the 4 5 judge assigned to the mental health diversionary program, shall distribute the proceeds of the court costs to the 7 circuit court and the district attorney for the creation, implementation, and continuing administration of a mental 8 health diversionary program, to be known as the "mental health 9 10 court."

(2) The fees shall not be waived by any court unless all other fees, assessments, costs, fines, and charges associated with the case are waived.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
