1 SB185

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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama
6 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted
7 during the 2021 Regular Session as contained in the 2021
8 Cumulative Supplements to certain volumes of the code and 2021
9 Replacement Volumes 4, 7A, and 17A; to initially adopt and
10 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, 2021 Volume 22M,
11 Local Laws Monroe to Perry Counties; and to adopt and
12 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, the 2021 Cumulative
13 Supplements to local law volumes; to make corrections in
14 certain volumes of the cumulative supplements and replacement
15 volumes; to specify that this adoption and incorporation
16 constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire
17 Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a
18 code; to declare that the Code Publisher has certified that it
19 has discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes;
20 to expressly provide that this act does not affect any 2022
21 session statutes; and to specify the duties of the Secretary
22 of State regarding the custody of the cumulative supplements
23 and replacement volumes.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. (a) (1) Those general and permanent laws
2 of the state enacted during the 2021 Regular Session as
3 contained in the 2021 Cumulative Supplements to Volume 3,
4 Volumes 5 to 7, inclusive, Volumes 8 to 17, inclusive, and
5 Volumes 17B to 22A, inclusive, and the 2021 Replacement
6 Volumes 4, 7A, and 17A, and the additions and deletions made
7 by the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and
8 published by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which
9 volumes of the 2021 Cumulative Supplements and 2021
10 Replacement Volumes are identified and authenticated by the
11 Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and
12 back of each of the volumes of the cumulative supplements and
13 upon the first inside page and the last inside page of the
14 replacement volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the
15 Code of Alabama 1975.

16 (2) Those general and permanent laws of the state
17 enacted during the 2021 Regular Session as contained in the
18 2021 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 22A, inclusive,
19 and the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner
20 for editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson
21 Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2021
22 Cumulative Supplements and 2021 Replacement Volumes are
23 identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of
24 Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of the volumes
25 of the cumulative supplements and upon the first inside page

1 and the last inside page of the replacement volumes, are
2 adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

3 (b) The following corrections are made:

4 (1) Section 15-22-32, 2021 Cumulative Supplement to
5 Volume 12B, pages 120 and 121. To correct a scrivener's error
6 which resulted in the use of incorrect terminology, in the
7 second sentence of paragraph (b)(1)c. and in the first
8 sentence of paragraph (e)(5)a., replace "the revocation
9 occurred" with "the violation occurred"

10 (2) Section 15-22-54, 2021 Cumulative Supplement to
11 Volume 12B, pages 132 and 134. To correct a scrivener's error
12 which resulted in the use of incorrect terminology, in the
13 second sentence of paragraph (e)(1)d. and in the first
14 sentence of subdivision (f)(5), replace "the revocation
15 occurred" with "the violation occurred"

16 (3) Section 16-6F-10, 2021 Cumulative Supplement to
17 Volume 13, page 111. To reletter internal references to
18 reflect the addition of a new paragraph a. during the
19 legislative process, in the first sentence of paragraph
20 (b)(1)d., replace "paragraph a." with "paragraph b." and in
21 the second sentence of paragraph (b)(1)d., replace "paragraph
22 b." with "paragraph c."

23 (4) Section 32-12A-1, 2021 Replacement Volume 17A,
24 pages 790 and 791. To correct a publishing error that occurred
25 during the harmonization of two amendatory acts, in the first

1 sentence of subdivisions (1) and (5), after the language "less
2 in width," insert "measured from the outside of the tire rim
3 to the outside of the tire rim directly across on the
4 vehicle," and in subdivision (5), replace "2,500" with "3,500"

5 (5) Section 40-18-384, 2021 Cumulative Supplement to
6 Volume 21A, page 179. To correct an internal cross-reference
7 to reflect code sections repealed and added by Act 2021-2, in
8 subdivision (a) (2) and in subsection (d), replace "Section
9 40-18-411(a) (2)c." with "Section 40-18-417.2(a) (2)b."

10 (6) Section 45-16-84.02, 2021 Cumulative Supplement
11 to Volume 22D, page 103. For purposes of organization and
12 clarity, to redesignate the code section as subdivisions
13 (c) (1), (2), and (3) of Section 45-16-241.20 and revise
14 internal references to achieve appropriate hierarchy as
15 follows:

16 "(c) (1) A Revenue Commissioner of Coffee County
17 elected on or after March 8, 2021, shall receive an annual
18 base salary of eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) per
19 year. Except as provided in subdivision (2), the salary shall
20 constitute the total compensation payable to the revenue
21 commissioner, and shall be in lieu of any salary, expense
22 allowance, or other compensation provided by law. The revenue
23 commissioner shall be paid from the same funds and in the same
24 manner as presently provided.

1 "(2) The annual salary provided in subdivision (1)
2 shall continue to be adjusted thereafter as authorized in
3 Chapter 2A of Title 11.

4 "(3) If there is a break in continuous service as
5 revenue commissioner on or after May 17, 2021, upon
6 reappointment or reelection as revenue commissioner, he or she
7 shall receive the base salary as provided in subdivision (1),
8 which may be adjusted as provided in subdivision (2)."

9 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the
10 state previously enacted and contained in the local and
11 permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during
12 the 2021 Regular Session, and the 2021 Regular Session as
13 contained in initial Volume 22M, Local Laws Monroe to Perry
14 Counties, and the 2021 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 22B,
15 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 22J, 22K, and 22L and the
16 additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner for
17 editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson
18 Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2021
19 Cumulative Supplement are identified and authenticated by the
20 Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and
21 back of each of the volumes of the cumulative supplements, are
22 adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

23 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
24 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act
25 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the

1 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the
2 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
3 as amended. This act is a law that adopts a code for the
4 purposes of Section 45 of the Official Recompilation of the
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. Notwithstanding
6 the foregoing, nothing in this act shall be deemed to codify
7 any provision of law that was adopted in violation of any
8 provision of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, establishing
9 requirements for, or limitations on, the enactment of a law.

10 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as
11 the Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its
12 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2021
13 Replacement Volumes 4, 7A, and 17A of the Code of Alabama
14 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes
15 with the material contained in the cumulative supplements
16 without making substantive changes, but making, under the
17 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code
18 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may
19 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of
20 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and
21 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and
22 misspellings.

23 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not
24 repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any

1 statute enacted into law during any 2022 session of the
2 Legislature.

3 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act,
4 the duly authenticated volumes of the 2021 Cumulative
5 Supplements, the 2021 Replacement Volumes, and the 2021
6 Cumulative Supplements shall be transmitted to the Secretary
7 of State, who shall file the volumes of the supplements and
8 the replacement volumes in that office. The volumes of the
9 supplements and replacement volumes shall not be removed from
10 the office of the Secretary of State, but the Secretary of
11 State, upon request, under proper certificate and seal of that
12 office, shall certify any part or parts thereof upon payment
13 of the fee specified by law for similar services.

14 Section 7. This act shall become effective
15 immediately following its passage and approval by the
16 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
