2.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Department of Examiners of Public

Accounts, in consultation with the Administrative Office of

Courts, shall prescribe minimum guidelines for the handling of

court costs, fees, and fines in municipal courts.

- (b) The guidelines shall include, at a minimum, that municipal courts may not accept cash for payments of court costs, fees, and fines, and that municipal courts shall provide a receipt for any payments made towards court costs, fees, and fines.
- (c) (1) Each municipal court shall annually certify to the Administrative Office of Courts that it is in compliance with this section.
- (2) The Administrative Office of Courts shall levy a civil penalty of up to one hundred dollars (\$100) to any municipal court who fails or willfully refuses to comply with the guidelines established pursuant to this section. Penalties imposed and collected under this section shall be paid into the State General Fund.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
