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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a violation of fleeing
9 or attempting to elude a law enforcement officer is
10 a felony if the flight or attempt to elude causes
11 death or physical injury to an innocent bystander
12 or a third party.

This bill would include additional activity that would constitute a felony for fleeing or attempting to elude a law enforcement officer.

Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds from becoming effective with regard to a local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote unless: it comes within one of a number of specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates

funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to
the entity for the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment.

However, the bill does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within one of the specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1	Section 1. Section 13A-10-52, Code of Alabama 1975,
2	is amended to read as follows:
3	"\$13A-10-52.
4	"(a) It shall be unlawful for a person to
5	intentionally flee by any means from anyone the person knows
6	to be a law enforcement officer if the person knows the
7	officer is attempting to arrest the person.
8	"(b) It shall be unlawful for a person while
9	operating a motor vehicle on a street, road, alley, or highway
10	in this state, to intentionally flee or attempt to elude a law
11	enforcement officer after having received a signal from the
12	officer to bring the vehicle to a stop.
13	"(c) $\underline{(1)}$ A violation of subsection (a) or (b) is a
14	Class A misdemeanor unless the.
15	"(2) A violation of subsection (a) or (b) is a Class
16	C felony under either of the following circumstances:
17	"a. Both of the following occur:
18	"1. The law enforcement officer attempting to arrest
19	the person has an arrest warrant for or has reasonable

7	more than two years."
8	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its
9	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased
10	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further
11	requirements and application under Amendment 621, as amended
12	by Amendment 890, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the
13	Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,
14	as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the
15	definition of an existing crime.
16	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
17	first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
