BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 1 2 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become 3 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of 4 5 this act are fulfilled: PROPOSED AMENDMENT 6 7 (a) Members of any of the following entities may 8 participate in a meeting of that entity by means of telephone conference, video conference, or other similar communications 9 10 equipment: (1) The Jefferson County Commission. 11 12 (2) The governing body of any municipality entirely 13 within Jefferson County. (3) Any board, body, or commission that is an 14 15 instrumentality of the county or a municipality entirely 16 within the county. 17 (4) A committee or subcommittee of any entity listed 18 in subdivision (1), (2), or (3). (b) Notice of any meeting held pursuant to 19 20 subsection (a) shall be provided as required by law for a 21 meeting of that entity. (c) Any entity listed in subdivision (1), (2), or 22 23 (3) of subsection (a) shall establish procedures for the

that entity or any committee or subcommittee of that entity,

in compliance with this amendment.

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment and contingent upon the ratification of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, the Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution based upon a logical sequence and the particular subject or topic of the amendment. In this amendment, the Code Commissioner may change capitalization, spelling, and punctuation for the purpose of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; and correct incorrect cross-references. The Code Commissioner, during publication, may also omit this instructional paragraph.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Jefferson County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the members of county and municipal entities may participate in meetings of that governmental body by electronic means, under certain conditions.
