- either of the following manners, provided that the posting is otherwise pursuant to law:
- 3 (1) On any website maintained and made publicly
  4 available by a county, provided that the website is
  5 continuously available to be viewed by the public 24 hours per
  6 day, each day of the year, except when made unavailable for
  7 necessary maintenance or by circumstances outside the control
  8 of the county.
  - (2) On an electronic display within that courthouse or other specific building, which is available to be viewed by the public in a manner substantially similar to the physical posting required by law.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
