Relating to Russell County; to provide for the compensation of the members of the county commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall apply only to Russell County.

Section 2. (a) (1) Effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this act, each member of the county commission shall receive an annual salary of twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) per year. The salary provided by this subdivision shall be in lieu of any salary, expense allowance, or other compensation provided by law on the effective date of this act.

- (2) Effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this act, the chair of the county commission shall receive an annual salary of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) per year. The salary provided by this subdivision shall be in lieu of any and all salary, expense allowance, or other compensation provided by law on the effective date of this act.
- (b) (1) The county commission, by majority recorded roll call vote of the entire elected members of the county commission, may grant to each member of the commission, not including the chair of the commission, an additional expense

L	allowance,	payable	in	equal	monthly	installments	from	the

- (2) Any expense allowance granted to the members of the commission shall become salary effective upon the next term of office following the term that the expense allowance becomes effective.
- (c) Notwithstanding any provision of this section or any other provision of the law to the contrary, the total annual compensation of any member of the county commission, including salary, expense allowance, and other compensation, may not exceed the total annual compensation of the chair of the commission.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
