25	that is designed and installed to work in conjunction with an

27	automatically record a photograph or digital image of a motor

- vehicle that depicts the license plate of the motor vehicle and depicts the recorded speed, date, location, and time of the recorded image of the vehicle.
- 4 (b) The use of a photographic speed enforcement system is prohibited in this state.

- (c) A speeding ticket issued in violation of this section shall be void.
- 8 (d) This act shall not apply to the use of radar in the line of duty by a certified law enforcement officer.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
