26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Each Tier II plan member who first begins eligible employment with a Teachers' Retirement System or an Employees' Retirement System participating employer on or after October 1, 2022, upon retirement shall be provided an annual automatic cost-of-living adjustment, in the amount of one percent of the gross benefit, only if the member has completed at least 30 years of creditable service.

8 (b) Any future survivor allowance shall be adjusted 9 as provided in the member's original option selection for 10 those eligible retirees who have selected a monthly survivor 11 allowance payable to a designated beneficiary upon the death 12 of the retiree.

13 (c) Any individual who receives benefits under the Medicaid program and whose eligibility for the benefits would 14 15 be impaired by the cost-of-living increase provided by this section may not receive the increase. Any individual who 16 17 subsequently applies for benefits under the Medicaid program 18 and who would have his or her eligibility to receive benefits impaired by the cost-of-living increase provided by this 19 20 section, may not receive the increase after the date that the 21 member files application for benefits under the Medicaid 22 program.

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective 24 immediately following its passage and approval by the 25 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
