3	SYNOPSIS:
4	Under existing law, if the plans for a fire alarm
5	system are required to be submitted to and approved by
6	a municipality, county, or the state, the plans are
7	required to bear the seal of a professional engineer
8	licensed in the State of Alabama or to be submitted by
9	a certified fire alarm contractor.
10	This bill would require all plans submitted for a
11	fire alarm system to bear the seal of a professional
12	engineer licensed in the State of Alabama and delete
13	provisions authorizing submission by a certified fire
14	alarm contractor.

20	Relating to fire alarm systems; to amend Section
21	34-33A-10, Code of Alabama 1975, to require the plans for a
22	fire alarm system submitted to and approved by a municipality,
23	a county, or the state, to bear the seal of a professional
24	engineer licensed in this state.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 34-33A-10, Code of Alabama 1975, is
27	amended to read as follows:
28	"\$34-33A-10



29 Nothing in this chapter limits the power of a municipality, county, or the state to regulate the guality and 30 character of work performed by contractors, through a system 31 32 of permits, fees, and inspections which are designed to assure 33 compliance with, and aid in the implementation of, state and 34 local building laws or to enforce other local laws for the 35 protection of the public health and safety. Nothing in this 36 chapter limits the power of a municipality, county, or the state to adopt any system of permits requiring submission to 37 38 and approval by the municipality, county, or the state, of 39 plans and specifications for work to be performed by 40 contractors before commencement of the work. If the plans for 41 a fire alarm system are required to be submitted to and 42 approved by any municipality, county, or the state, or any 43 departments or agencies thereof, the plans shall bear the seal of a professional engineer licensed in the State of Alabama-or 44 be submitted by a certified fire alarm contractor. The 45 46 official authorized to issue building or other related permits shall ascertain that the fire alarm contractor is duly 47 48 certified by requiring evidence of a valid State Fire 49 Marshal's permit."

50 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately 51 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 52 otherwise becoming law.
