14	Section 1. Section 45-38-101 of the Code of Alabama
15	1975, is amended to read as follows:

17	Beginning with the next term of office, the county
18	superintendent of education in Lamar County shall receive an
19	annual salary which shall not be more than 25 percent in
20	excess of the highest salary paid to any other employee in the
21	county school system. The salary herein provided for the
22	<pre>superintendent that shall be fixed by the county board of</pre>
23	education and shall be payable in equal monthly installments
24	out of the county funds available for such that purpose. In
25	addition to <u>such</u> the salary, the superintendent shall <u>furnish</u>
26	his or her own automobile and shall be reimbursed for
27	out-of-county and out-of-state travel on official business at
28	the rate of twenty cents (\$.20) per mile and on an actual

29	expense basis for any other expenses incurred in performance
30	of official duties same per diem and mileage as provided to
31	<pre>state employees."</pre>
32	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately
33	following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
34	otherwise becoming law.
