8	Relating to the City of Columbiana in Shelby County; to
9	authorize the City Council of the City of Columbiana to
10	establish and regulate the operation of entertainment
11	districts in the city as designated by the Columbiana City
12	Code; and to authorize the city council to provide penalties
13	for violations.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Section 1. This act is adopted pursuant to
16	the authority in subdivision (31) of Section 104 of the
17	Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
18	Section 2. (a) The City Council of the City of
19	Columbiana by ordinance may provide for the establishment of
20	not more than two entertainment districts in the city, as
21	those districts are defined in the Columbiana City Code. The
22	entertainment districts may contain one or more Alcoholic
23	Beverage Control Board licensees in an area that does not
24	exceed one-half mile by one-half mile. The ordinance of the
25	city council shall regulate hours of operation of an
26	entertainment district, may provide for the revocation of the
27	entertainment district designation, and may regulate any other
28	aspect of the operation of entertainment districts.

29	(b) Any retail licensee of the Alabama Alcoholic
30	Beverage Control Board licensed to sell alcoholic beverages
31	for on-premises consumption located in an entertainment
32	district may obtain an entertainment district permit.
33	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any licensee that
34	receives an entertainment district permit shall comply with
35	all laws and rules governing its license, except that patrons,
36	guests, or members of the licensee may exit the licensed
37	premises with open containers of alcoholic beverages anywhere
38	within the confines of the entertainment district, but may not
39	enter the premises of another licensee with open containers or
40	closed containers of alcoholic beverages acquired elsewhere.
41	In addition, the ordinance shall prohibit a person other than
42	a retail licensee from possessing or bringing in the
43	entertainment district an open or closed container of
44	alcoholic beverages acquired outside of the entertainment
45	district during the hours of operation of the entertainment
46	district.
47	(c) The ordinance of the city council shall be enforced
48	by the City of Columbiana and shall provide penalties for
49	violations of the ordinance as otherwise authorized by law.
50	Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
51	with this act are repealed.
52	Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately
53	following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
54	otherwise becoming law.
