1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and
4 corporate limits of the municipality of Skyline in Jackson
5 County.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits of
8 the municipality of Skyline in Jackson County are altered,
9 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
10 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now
11 included, all of the following territory:

12 TRACT ONE

13 All of the Eastern one-half of the right-of-way, and
14 the road and territory inclusive lying therein the Eastern
15 one-half of the right-of-way, along Jackson County Road 544,
16 bounded on the south by the present corporate boundaries of
17 the municipality of Skyline, thence, from the intersection of
18 said county road with Alabama Highway 146, north along and
19 encompassing the right-of-way, and the road and territory
20 inclusive lying therein of Alabama Highway 146 to the center
21 of said highway's intersection with Jackson County Road 138;
22 thence from the intersection of said highway with Jackson
23 County Road 138, north along and encompassing the
24 right-of-way, and the road and territory inclusive lying
25 therein of County Road 138 extending 1.7 miles along said
26 right-of-way until the end point in Jackson County, Alabama;

27 TRACT TWO

28 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory

29 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Jackson County
30 Road 17, bounded on the north by the present southern
31 corporate boundaries of the municipality of Skyline on said
32 county road, extending 2.1 miles along said right-of-way until
33 the end point in Jackson County, Alabama;

34 TRACT THREE

35 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory
36 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Jackson County
37 Road 15, beginning where County Road 17 intersects County Road
38 15, extending 0.82 miles along said right-of-way until the end
39 point in Jackson County, Alabama;

40 TRACT FOUR

41 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory
42 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Jackson County
43 Road 317, beginning where County Road 17 intersects County
44 Road 317 at each end of a .13 mile long loop, encompassing the
45 entirety of the right-of-way of said loop, then along said
46 county road, extending from the point at which said loop joins
47 to form one roadway 1.18 miles along said right-of-way until
48 the end point in Jackson County, Alabama;

53 TRACT FIVE

54 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory
55 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Jackson County
56 Road 222, beginning where County Road 17 intersects County

57 Road 222, extending 0.35 miles along said right-of-way until
58 the end point in Jackson County, Alabama;

59 TRACT SIX

60 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory
61 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Alabama
62 Highway 79 beginning at the present northern corporate
63 boundary of the Town of Skyline, Alabama, on said highway and
64 extending north to the endpoint, at the southern corporate
65 boundaries of the Town of Hytop, Alabama immediately south of
66 said highway's intersection with Alabama Highway 146; and

67 TRACT SEVEN

68 All of the right-of-way, and the road and territory
69 inclusive lying between the right-of-way, along Jackson County
70 Road 144, beginning where Alabama Highway 79 intersects County
71 Road 144, extending 0.96 miles north and east along said
72 right-of-way until the end point in Jackson County, Alabama.

73 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6 of the
74 Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing the proposed territory to
75 be annexed to the municipality of Skyline is on file and open
76 to public inspection in the Office of the Judge of Probate in
77 Jackson County, Alabama.

78 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
79 day of the third month following its passage and approval by
80 the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
