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9	Relating to Calhoun County; to authorize the license
10	commissioner to void a motor vehicle license plate, decal,
11	sales and use tax, issuance fees, interest, penalties, and
12	costs when a check or credit card tendered by an individual,
13	company, or other entity for payment of any motor vehicle
14	license is found non-collectible at the time of deposit; and
15	to provide for the reimbursement from the General Fund of
16	Calhoun County to the License Commissioner for losses by the
17	office of the license commissioner for errors and
18	omissions.
19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. This act shall only apply in Calhoun County.
21	Section 2. When a check or credit card tendered by an
22	individual, company, or other entity for payment of any motor
23	vehicle license, vessel registration, privilege license, door
24	to door sales license, rental lease, driver license, or
25	manufactured home registration is found to be non-collectible
26	at the time of deposit, the license commissioner or license
27	inspector shall make a reasonable attempt to retrieve the
28	motor vehicle license plate or decal and to retrieve all other

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29 licenses and decals for the enforcement of this section. In 30 the event the motor vehicle license plate, decal, or other 31 licenses cannot be retrieved, the license commissioner may 32 void sales and use taxes, issuance fees, interest, penalties, 33 and costs. After the motor vehicle or other licenses have been 34 voided, the license commissioner shall receive credit for 35 costs associated with the non-collectible check, credit card, 36 or instrument issued. The appropriate state office shall mark 37 the records pertaining to the voided license accordingly, and upon inquiry by any law enforcement agency, shall notify the 38 39 agency that the party in question is operating under a voided license. All violations shall be prosecuted in accordance to 40 law. 41

Section 3. The Calhoun County Commission shall 42 43 reimburse the office of the License Commissioner of Calhoun County from the General Fund of Calhoun County up to three 44 thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500) per year for the amount 45 46 of any losses arising or caused by any errors, mistakes, or 47 omissions of the license commissioner or his or her agents if 48 caused without personal knowledge, including losses arising 49 from acceptance of worthless or forged checks, drafts, money 50 orders, credit cards, or other written or online orders for 51 money or its equivalent.

52 Section 4. The license commissioner shall ensure that 53 his or her employees exercise due care in performing their 54 duties and make a diligent effort to correct any error, 55 mistake, or omission and collect the amount subject to 56 potential loss immediately upon becoming aware of the

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potential loss. This section shall not apply to any deliberate 57 misuse or misappropriation of funds by the license 58 59 commissioner or any clerk or employees of the office. 60 Section 5. The provisions of this act are supplemental 61 and it shall be construed in pari materia with other laws 62 regarding the office of the license commissioner. Section 6. All laws or parts of laws which are in 63 64 direct conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed. Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately 65 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 66 67 otherwise becoming law.
