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4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, on October 1, 1999, the
6	juvenile probation services and juvenile probation
7	officers in Mobile County and in all counties having a
8	population of 99,000 or less, according to the 1990
9	federal census, were transferred to the state court
10	system and the Administrative Office of Courts. In
11	1990, the population of Shelby County was 99,358.
12	Recently, the Attorney General ruled that Shelby County
13	has no control over the delivery of juvenile probation
14	services.
15	This bill would provide that juvenile probation
16	services in Shelby County would be included in the
17	transfer to the state court system.

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23	Relating to juvenile probation services; to amend
24	Section 12-5A-13 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to include
25	Shelby County in the counties where juvenile court services
26	are under the control of the state court system and the
27	Administrative Office of Courts.
