5	Act 2022-229 provided for a one-time lump-sum
6	addition to the retirement benefits of certain retirees
7	and beneficiaries of the Employees' Retirement System
8	and gave local units participating in the Employees'
9	Retirement System the option to come under the
10	provisions of the act.
11	This bill would extend the provisions of Act
12	2022-229 to allow local units additional time to elect
13	to come under the act's provisions.

21	2022-229 to allow local units participating in the Employees'
22	Retirement System additional time to elect to come under the
23	provisions of the act.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. The provisions of Act 2022-229 as they apply
26	to employers participating in the Employees' Retirement System
27	pursuant to Sections 36-27-6, 36-27-7, and 36-27-7.1, Code of
28	Alabama 1975, shall be extended if a participating employer

elects to come under the provisions of Act 2022-229 by 29 30 official resolution on or before October 31, 2023. Upon such election by official resolution on or before October 31, 2023, 31 32 the lump-sum payments provided under Act 2022-229 shall be 33 paid to all eligible recipients who are entitled to receive a 34 lump-sum payment under Act 2022-229 and are receiving a 35 benefit as of April 1, 2023, by the Employees' Retirement 36 System in December 2023. Any employer making such election 37 shall bear the cost of the lump-sum payment paid to its retirees, as provided in Act 2022-229. 38

39 Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately 40 following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 41 otherwise becoming law.
