4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing constitutional law, local laws
6	must be advertised for four consecutive weeks prior to
7	introduction in the Legislature.
8	This bill would propose an amendment to the
9	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to require local
10	constitutional amendments to be advertised via
11	publication on the website of the affected community
12	for four consecutive weeks prior to introduction.

18	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
19	of 2022, to add Section 284.02, to require local
20	constitutional amendments to be advertised prior to
21	introduction.
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
24	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed and shall become valid as a
25	part of the Constitution when approved by a majority of the
26	qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with
27	Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of
28	2022:

30	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
31	Section 284.02 is added to the Constitution of Alabama
32	of 2022 to read as follows:
33	Section 284.02
34	No local constitutional amendment shall be passed
35	unless the substance of the proposed constitutional amendment
36	is prominently published on the website of the county or
37	political subdivision affected by the constitutional amendment
38	for a period of not less than four consecutive weeks prior to
39	the introduction of the constitutional amendment. Proof of
40	notice shall be provided to the Clerk of the House or
41	Secretary of the Senate at the time the constitutional
42	amendment is introduced.
43	Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the

Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment, the appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: change capitalization, spelling, and punctuation for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; and correct incorrect cross-references.

51 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 52 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 53 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this 54 state.

55 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 56 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 57 58 following description of the substance or subject matter of 59 the proposed constitutional amendment: 60 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama 61 of 2022, to require every local constitutional amendment to be 62 published on the website of the affected county or political 63 subdivision for a period of four weeks prior to introduction 64 of the local constitutional amendment by the Legislature. Proposed by Act ." 65 66 This description shall be followed by the following 67 language:
