10	45-39-200.05 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the
11	Office of License Commissioner, to further provide for a mail
12	fee for the renewal of business licenses by mail.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 45-39-200.05 of the Code of Alabama
15	1975, is amended to read as follows:
16	"§45-39-200.05
17	(a) Before any person, firm, or corporation shall may
18	engage in or carry on any business or other activity in the
19	county for which a license is required by law, a license for
20	the activity shall be purchased from the commissioner and he
21	or she shall be entitled to charge a fee of one dollar (\$1)
22	for the issuance of the license. All costs, fees, and
23	penalties, which shall have accrued or for which such the
24	person, firm, or corporation shall have become is liable in
25	any proceeding commenced for the collection of same, shall be
26	paid before any license is eligible for renewal. The
27	commissioner shall issue the license countersigned by him or
28	her in the form and on the blank furnished to him or her by

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29 the State Department of Finance which shall set forth and 30 specify the name of the person, firm, or the corporation 31 applying therefor, the business or activity which it proposes 32 to carry on thereunder, the address where it proposes to carry 33 on the same business, the time for which it is issued, and if 34 the license is for a peddler, it shall state whether he or she 35 proposes to travel on foot, on horseback, or on by wagon, or 36 on by motor vehicle. The license shall not be transferable except as otherwise provided by law, nor shall it entitle the 37 holder thereof to carry on any other business or do any other 38 39 act other than that named herein at any other location than that specified; provided, however, that should it become 40 necessary to move any business from one location to another 41 42 location in the county, and such the business is to continue 43 in the same kind and character and by the same person or firm as that carried on at the former location, then, another 44 45 license shall not be required for the same licensed year. 46 (b) The commissioner if he or she elects to do so, may 47 mail an application for renewal of a license to all persons, 48 firms, and corporations to whom a license was issued during 49 that license year as reflected on the records in his or her 50 office. For preparing such the application and mailing the 51 application same by first class mail to the address of the 52 person, firm, or corporation—as listed on the license records 53 in his or her office, he or she shall be entitled to a mailing 54 and for the return of a renewed license, the license commissioner shall charge and collect a mail fee of one dollar 55 56 (\$1) for each mailing, such mailing fee to. The commissioner,



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with the approval of the county commission, may increase the	
amount of the mail fee by a reasonable amount to adequately	
cover the costs of handling and mailing of each renewed	
license. The mail fee shall be paid at the same time and in	
the same manner as other license issuance fees are paid."	
Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately	
following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its	
otherwise becoming law.
