7	TO BE ENTITLED
8	AN ACT
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10	Relating to Mobile County; to amend Sections 45-49-181,
11	45-49-181.02, 45-49-181.03, 45-49-181.04, and 45-49-181.08,
12	Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for acceptance by the
13	county of certain unimproved roads from private landowners;
14	and to regulate the construction of certain other unimproved
15	roads.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. Sections 45-49-181, 45-49-181.03,
18	45-49-181.04, and 45-49-181.08, Code of Alabama 1975, are
19	amended to read as follows:
20	"§45-49-181
21	The County Commission of Mobile County may accept each
22	year a total number of miles of public roads equal to the
23	number of miles of county maintained dirt roads graded,
24	drained, based, and paved under any pay-as-you-go program
25	during the preceding calendar year and shall not accept any
26	other dirt or otherwise substandard road constructed or
27	improved after January 1, 1984. The county commission shall
28	require that the division of a lot, tract, or parcel of land

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into two or more lots, plats, sites, or other divisions of 30 land for the purpose, whether immediate or future, divided for 31 purposes of sale or of building development shall be done by 32 recorded plat in accordance with Section 35-2-50." 33 "\$45-49-181.02 34 A chair shall be designated on this petition to 35 represent the petitioners and to act on their behalf. A map of 36 legible size indicating the location of the named road shall 37 be presented with the petition. The petition should clearly state the name to be assigned to the road. The petition shall 38 39 certify to the intent of the adjacent property owners to offer jointly, at no cost to the county, a minimum of 60-foot width 40 of right-of-way, along an alignment that complies with 41 42 accepted design criteria and does not compromise the safety of 43 the traveling public, together with any required drainage easements as determined by the county engineer to adequately 44 45 maintain the road. The petition shall certify that the 46 adjacent property owners will jointly and severally indemnify 47 the county against liability for roadway defects for a period 48 not to exceed five years after acceptance of the road or roads 49 by the county. The petition shall certify that the 50 petitioners, at their expense, shall provide funds for the 51 purchase of the necessary driveway culvert pipe approved by 52 the county engineer as further provided in Section 53 45-49-181.03 for installation by the county as a prerequisite to acceptance and maintenance. The petition shall certify that 54 55 the petitioners, at their expense, shall pay for the

56 relocation of any utilities and any fences required to



57 accommodate the necessary roadway improvements and associated 58 drainage improvements."

60 (a) On or prior to the first day of the month of February, the county commission shall submit copies of each 61 petition received to the county engineer. The county engineer, 62 63 on or prior to the last day of the month of March of the same 64 year, shall return to the commission a prioritized list of the 65 roads submitted by petitioners. This prioritized list shall be based on the density of development along each road. The list 66 67 shall designate the commission district in which the road is located. The county commission shall review the list of 68 eligible roads, and on or prior to the last day of April, 69 70 shall return to the county engineer the prioritized list 71 designating those roads which shall be considered for acceptance for the county road maintenance system in 72 73 accordance with the prioritized density of development.

74 (b) The county commission shall concurrently notify the 75 chair for the petitioners of each selected road to contact the 76 county engineer to coordinate the right-of-way acquisition, 77 utility relocations, fence relocations, and the approval by 78 the county engineer of any culvert pipe the chair for the 79 petitioners proposes to purchase for use as of driveway 80 culvert pipe, should the chair choose to purchase pipe from a 81 private party. The county engineer shall approve the proposed driveway culvert pipe so long as the culvert pipe meets the 82 specifications of the applicable building code." 83 84 "\$45-49-181.04



The following sequence dates shall apply to this part: (1) January: Petitions for road maintenance may be accepted by the county commission only during the month of January.

89 (2) February: Petitions forwarded to the county90 engineer for analysis and recommendations.

91 (3) March: On or before the last day of the month of
92 March, the county engineer shall submit a prioritized list of
93 roads submitted by petition to the county commission.

94 (4) April: On or before the last day of the month of
95 April, the county commission shall designate those roads which
96 will be considered for addition to the county road maintenance
97 system.

98 (5) May: Prior to or during the first regular
99 commission meeting in the month of May, the county commission
100 shall assign consultants to prepare surveys, construction
101 plans, and deed and easement documents.

102 (6) July: The consultant designated by the commission 103 shall have until the last day of July to prepare right-of-way 104 deed and easement documents, as required. On or prior to the 105 last day of the month of July, the county engineer shall 106 notify the chair for each petition selected by the commission 107 that the right-of-way deed and easement documents are prepared 108 and request that the chair begin work toward the execution of 109 the documents.

(7) August: The consultant designated by the commission shall have until the last day of August to complete the design of the roadway improvements and the associated drainage



113 improvements. On or prior to the last day of August, the county engineer shall notify the chair for each petition that 114 115 the construction plans for the roadway have been completed and 116 are ready for use in coordinating the relocation of utilities and, the relocation of fences, and the purchase of approved 117 118 driveway culvert pipe. The chair processes the right-of-way 119 deed and easement documents and coordinates activities with 120 the property owners.

(8) September: On or prior to the last day of the month of September, all right-of-way deed and easement documents shall be executed and returned to the county engineer by the chair. The chair shall also have until the last day of September to submit any proposed culvert pipe to the county engineer for his or her approval to be used as driveway culvert pipe.

(9) October: The chair shall work on the coordination
of utility relocations and the collection of funds from the
individual property owners for the purchase of driveway
culvert pipe. The county engineer shall also have until the
last day of October to communicate to the chair the approval
status of the pipe submitted for use as driveway culvert pipe.

(10) November: On or prior to the last day of the month of November, the chair shall have reported to the county engineer that all utility relocations have been completed, that all fences have been relocated, and that all the funds have been collected and delivered for the purchase of all of the required approved driveway culvert pipe has been purchased. to the county engineer's office. The county shall



141 deposit the delivered funds for the purchase of driveway culvert pipe into an escrow account for this road improvement. 142 143 (11) December: On or prior to the last day of the month 144 of December, the county commission shall accept those roads on 145 which the chair has met all the requirements set out in this 146 part at an official county commission meeting and instruct the 147 county engineer to place the roads on the county road 148 maintenance system." 149 "\$45-49-181.08 The chair designated on the petition shall be the 150 151 official representative for the petitioners and shall be responsible for the following duties: 152 153 (1) Upon notification by the county commission that the 154 road has been selected for the program, the chair shall 155 contact the county engineer and coordinate all further activities with that office. 156 157 (2) The chair shall be responsible for getting all 158 right-of-way deed and easement documents executed and 159 submitted to the county engineer on or prior to the last day 160 of the month of September. All deed and easement documents

161 necessary for the road to be accepted in the program shall be 162 submitted together in one submittal.

163 (3) The chair shall coordinate the relocation of all 164 utilities necessary for the proper maintenance of the road 165 with the proper utility authorities and shall notify the 166 county engineer when all such relocations have been completed.

167 (4) The chair shall coordinate the collection of funds168 from the individual property owners for the purchase of all



169	driveway culvert pipes and deliver a single cashier's check
170	for the total amount of all the funds for all the required
171	driveway culvert pipes to the county engineer. The chair shall
172	provide a list of the funds collected for each tract or
173	property along the selected roadway. <u>The chair shall also</u>
174	submit the culvert pipe they propose to purchase for use as
175	driveway culvert pipe to the county engineer for approval.
