Section 2. (a) Beginning January 1 following the effective date of this act, each person who applies for a new driver's license, nondriver identification card, or vessel license, or a learner's license or permit, or the renewal of any of these licenses, cards, or permits, may provide the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency with the name and contact information for the contact of a person in the event of an emergency. The emergency contact information provided in this section shall be stored in the records of the agency and made available to law enforcement personnel for contact in the event law enforcement deems contact is in the best interest of the licensee or card holder.

(b) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency may adopt rules necessary to carry out this act.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
