25	Section 1. (a) As used in this section, a qualifying
26	graduate is an individual who has graduated with a bachelor's
27	degree or equivalent from a four-year public institution of

higher education in the state and who has received a scholarship issued by that institution to attend that institution.

4 (b) A qualifying graduate who cannot find meaningful
5 employment within one year of graduation shall be entitled to
6 attend a two-year public institution of higher education in
7 the state, free of tuition costs, in order to attain an
8 associate's degree or technical certificate from that two-year
9 institution.

10 (c) The Commission on Higher Education shall adopt 11 rules to implement this section, including, but not limited 12 to, standards for determining who qualifies for relief under 13 this section.

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
