Section 1. (a) The Department of Revenue shall make available to the public a record of statutorily tax exempt entities that have been issued a sales, use, or lodgings tax certificate of exemption. The record shall be limited to the entity name, the date of issuance, and the current status of the certificate as either valid or invalid, including the date any certificate of exemption became invalid.

(b) An annual consolidated report of the records provided for in subsection (a) shall be provided by the Department of Revenue to the Fiscal Division of the Legislative Services Agency not less than three weeks preceding the start of each legislative session.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming law.
