PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Legislature, by local law applicable to those areas of Chilton County outside the corporate limits of any municipality, may establish a procedure by which a dog can be declared dangerous and be humanely destroyed and impose criminal penalties on the owners of a dog declared to be dangerous.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of 12 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 13 284 and Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the 14 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election 15 laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
