Section 3. The city shall hold a referendum to determine whether to grant authority to the city council to provide for the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday pursuant to the authority specified in the referendum. The referendum shall specify whether the authority granted to the city council would include the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sundays for on-premises consumption and the time the sale of alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption may commence and whether the authority granted to the city council would include the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sundays for off-premises consumption and the time the sale of alcoholic beverages may commence. The referendum may be presented as one question or as separate questions related to on-premises and off-premises consumption. If a majority of the voters voting thereon vote in favor of the question or questions, the sale of alcoholic beverages as authorized in this act on Sunday may be provided for by the city council subject to the referendum.

Section 4. The referendum shall be held at the next regular municipal election or at a special municipal election called for that purpose by the city council. Costs of the referendum shall be paid by the city. A second or subsequent

referendum shall not be held within 12 months following a
referendum which fails to be approved by the voters of the
city or to further authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages
on Sunday pursuant to this act.

Section 5. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
