16	for one member of the commission to provide that he

22	AN ACT

24	Relating to the membership of the Environmental
25	Management Commission of the Alabama Department of
26	Environmental Management; to amend Section 22-22A-6, Code of
27	Alabama 1975; to provide that one member of the commission may

be an individual licensed by the Alabama Board of Licensure
 for Professional Geologists.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 22-22A-6, Code of Alabama 1975,
is amended to read as follows:

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"§22-22A-6.

7 "(a) There is hereby created a seven member
8 Environmental Management Commission of the Alabama Department
9 of Environmental Management which shall have the following
10 duties:

"(1) To select a director for the Department of Environmental Management and to advise the director on environmental matters which are within the department's scope of authority;

15 "(2) To establish, adopt, promulgate, modify,
16 repeal, and suspend any rules, regulations or environmental
17 standards for the department which may be applicable to the
18 state as a whole or any of its geographical parts;

19 "(3) To develop environmental policy for the state;
20 and

"(4) To hear and determine appeals of administrativeactions.

"(b) The Environmental Management Commission shall
be composed of seven members who are citizens of the State of
Alabama. Initial members of the commission shall be appointed
to places on the Environmental Management Commission by the
Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives pursuant to the procedure set out in 2 subsection (d) of this section with the advice and consent of the Senate. Initial appointments shall be made on or before 3 October 1, 1982. All subsequent appointments to places on the 4 5 Environmental Management Commission after the initial appointments shall be made by the Governor with the advice and 6 7 consent of the Senate. No member of the Environmental 8 Management Commission may serve more than a total of 18 years. 9 When a vacancy occurs during a period when the Legislature is 10 not in session to advise and consent, such appointee shall have the full power of the office until and unless the Senate, 11 12 upon the reconvening of the Legislature, shall by affirmative 13 vote refuse to consent in such appointment. Qualifications of the seven members shall be as follows: 14

"(1) One member shall be a physician licensed to practice medicine in the State of Alabama and shall be familiar with environmental matters;

18 "(2) One member shall be a professional engineer
19 registered in the State of Alabama and shall be familiar with
20 environmental matters;

"(3) One member shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Alabama and shall be familiar with environmental matters;

24 "(4) One member shall be a chemist possessing as a 25 minimum a bachelor's degree from an accredited university or a 26 veterinarian licensed to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Alabama and shall be familiar with environmental
 matters;

3 "(5) One member that who has been certified by the
4 National Water Well Association Certification Program or is
5 licensed by the Alabama Board of Licensure for Professional
6 Geologists;

7 "(6) One member shall be a biologist or an ecologist 8 possessing as a minimum a bachelor's degree from an accredited 9 university and shall have training in environmental matters; 10 and

"(7) One member shall be a resident of the state for at least two years but shall not be required to have any specialized experience.

14 "(c) At the expiration of the terms of all members 15 initially appointed, their successors shall be promptly appointed by the Governor for terms of six years. At the 16 17 expiration of a term of office or in the event of a vacancy on 18 the Environmental Management Commission, the Governor shall 19 promptly make an appointment to fill the vacancy. The expiring 20 term of an incumbent member shall be continued until an 21 appointment is made.

"(d) Provided however that the initial appointments
to the Environmental Management Commission shall be made as
follows notwithstanding the other provisions of this chapter:

"(1) The Governor shall appoint three members of the
 Environmental Management Commission, two of whom shall come
 from the voting members of the boards or commissions abolished

by this chapter. The Governor's three initial appointments shall fill the positions described in subdivisions (4), (6), and (7) of subsection (b) of this section. The terms of these initial position appointments shall be for six years.

5 "(2) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint two members of the Environmental Management Commission, one who 6 7 shall come from the voting members of the boards or commissions abolished by this chapter. The Lieutenant 8 9 Governor's appointments pursuant to this subsection shall fill 10 the positions described in subdivisions (1) and (5) of subsection (b) of this section. The term of the initial 11 position described in subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of 12 13 this section shall be for four years. The term of the initial position described in subdivision (5) of subsection (b) of 14 15 this section shall be for two years.

16 "(3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives 17 shall appoint two members of the Environmental Management 18 Commission, one who shall come from the voting members of the boards or commissions abolished by this chapter. The Speaker 19 20 of the House of Representatives' appointments pursuant to this 21 subsection shall fill the positions described in subdivisions 22 (2) and (3) of subsection (b) of this section. The term of the initial position described in subdivision (2) of subsection 23 24 (b) of this section shall be for four years. The term of the 25 initial position described in subdivision (3) of subsection 26 (b) of this section shall be for two years.

1 "(e) The Environmental Management Commission shall 2 select a chairman chair from among its members, and the chairman's chair's term of office shall be determined by the 3 Environmental Management Commission, but shall not exceed 4 5 three consecutive years. The Environmental Management Commission shall not take official action unless a quorum is 6 7 present. A quorum shall be any four of the seven members. Recusal of a member shall not affect the guorum. 8

9 "(f) The Environmental Management Commission shall 10 meet regularly, at least once every two months at times and places to be fixed by the Environmental Management Commission. 11 12 Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the 13 chairman chair of the Environmental Management Commission and 14 special meetings shall be called by him or her on written 15 request of any four members to take up any matters within the 16 jurisdiction of the Environmental Management Commission. All 17 members shall be notified of the time and place of any regular 18 or special meeting in any one of the following ways: in In writing or by telegram to a member's last known address as 19 20 provided to the department or by telephone.

"(g) Any member of the Environmental Management Commission who misses three consecutive regularly scheduled meetings, shall immediately cease to be a member of the commission and the Governor shall promptly appoint a new member with appropriate qualifications to fill the remainder of the term.

"(h) The Environmental Management Commission shall
 keep a complete and accurate record of the proceedings of all
 its meetings, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the
 office of the director and open to public inspection.

5 "(i)(1) Each member shall receive \$100.00 one
6 <u>hundred dollars (\$100)</u> per day for each day of attendance at
7 an official meeting. Members of the Environmental Management
8 Commission shall be reimbursed for expenses when attending
9 meetings which are approved and certified by the director.
10 Reimbursement shall be in accordance with Sections 36-7-1
11 through 36-7-42;

"(2) All proper expenses of the Environmental
Management Commission shall be paid from the appropriations to
or funds of the department in the same manner as expenses of
the department are paid.

16 "(j) Members of the Environmental Management 17 Commission shall meet all requirements of the state ethics law 18 and the conflict of interest provisions of applicable federal 19 laws and regulations."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
