"(2) He or she annually completes and passes the 9 10 firearm requalification required of law enforcement officers by the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training 11 Commission. 12 13 "(3) He or she must carry a non-lethal weapon and must be trained in the appropriate use of that non-lethal 14 15 weapon. 16 "(d) Only those school resource officers who are 17 certified by the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and 18 Training Commission shall have the power of arrest. 19 "(b) (d) (e) The State Department of Education shall 20 promulgate any necessary rules to provide for the 21 implementation of this section including, but not limited to, 22 rules providing additional qualifications for employment as school security personnel or school resource officers." 23 24 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 25 first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 26
