13 Relating to Baldwin County; to amend Section
14 45-2-234.40 of the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the
15 retirement of law enforcement officers in the sheriff's
16 office; to further specify that a retiring officer may be
17 furnished with a firearm by the department.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Section 45-2-234.40 of the Code of
20 Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

21 "§45-2-234.40.

22 "~~(a)~~ Any individual employed by the Baldwin County
23 Sheriff's office as a law enforcement officer, including the
24 sheriff, for a period of 10 years or more who retires from the
25 department in good standing may receive from the sheriff,
26 without cost, a retired badge, a retired commission card, and

1 a ~~pistol~~ firearm, provided the ~~pistol~~ firearm is furnished by
2 the department.

3 ~~"(b) The provisions of this section are retroactive~~
4 ~~to January 15, 1991."~~

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
