Section 1. Section 7 of Act 2017-354, now appearing
 as Section 41-9-236 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to
 read as follows:

4 "\$41-9-236.

5 "This article does not apply to any of the 6 following:

7 "(1) Art and artifacts in the collections of
8 museums, archives, and libraries.

9 "(2) Any architecturally significant building,
10 memorial building, memorial street, or monument that is any of
11 the following:

"a. Located on public property under the control of, or acquired by, the State Department of Transportation, which may interfere with the construction, maintenance, or operation of the public transportation system. The department shall strive to ensure that any architecturally significant building, memorial building, memorial street, or monument is preserved to the greatest extent possible.

19 "b. Located on public property under the control of, 20 or acquired by, a county or municipal body or a university, 21 which may interfere with the construction, maintenance, or 22 operation of the public transportation system. The governing 23 body of the county, municipality, or university shall strive 24 to ensure that any architecturally significant building, 25 memorial building, memorial street, or monument is preserved to the greatest extent possible. 26

"c. Located on public property operated or used by a utility, which may interfere with providing utility service. The utility shall strive to ensure that any architecturally significant building, memorial building, memorial street, or monument is preserved to the greatest extent possible.

6 "d. Located on public property under the control of, 7 or acquired by, the Alabama State Port Authority, which may 8 interfere with the construction, maintenance, or operation of 9 the port infrastructure or port related activities. The 10 authority shall strive to ensure that any architecturally 11 significant building, memorial building, memorial street, or 12 monument is preserved to the greatest extent possible.

"<u>e. Located on public property under the control of,</u>
or acquired by, a Class 1 municipality."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
