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8 SYNOPSIS: Under present law, the fiscal year of the
9 state begins on October 1 and ends on September 30.

10 This bill would change the beginning of the
11 fiscal year for the State of Alabama and
12 instrumentalities of the state to July 1 of each
13 year, starting with the 2020 fiscal year which is
14 to begin July 1, 2019.

15 This bill would provide for the definition
16 of the fiscal year for the state; change the date
17 of the fiscal year; provide for a nine-month
18 implementation fiscal year from October 1, 2019
19 through June 30, 2020; and authorize the Governor
20 to promulgate procedures necessary to implement
21 this act.

22 This bill would provide that all
23 appropriations made for the term that is the
24 current lawful fiscal year 2020 would be allotted
25 to conform with the nine-month implementation
26 fiscal year and the first quarter of the 2021
27 fiscal year; provide that all sum certain

1 distributions of tax revenue shall be made at 75
2 percent (made at the nine months of estimated
3 monthly revenue) of the sum certain amounts during
4 the implementation fiscal year; and authorize
5 conformity of dates with the new fiscal year as
6 provided herein with the Code of Alabama 1975.

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8 A BILL
9 TO BE ENTITLED
10 AN ACT

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12 To amend Sections 1-3-4, 11-8-1, 16-13-1, 11-43A-29,
13 11-43A-94, 11-43C-41, 11-44C-41, and 11-44E-110 Code of
14 Alabama 1975, to change the date of the fiscal year and to
15 provide for the implementation of the new fiscal year period.
16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Sections 1-3-4, 11-8-1, 16-13-1,
18 11-43A-29, 11-43A-94, 11-43C-41, 11-44C-41, and 11-44E-110
19 Code of Alabama 1975, are hereby amended to read as follows:

20 "§1-3-4.

21 "The fiscal year of the government shall commence on
22 the first day of October and end on the thirtieth day of
23 September. This fiscal year shall be used for purposes of
24 making appropriations and of financial reporting and shall be
25 uniformly adopted by all departments, institutions, bureaus,
26 boards, commissions and other state agencies.

1 "(b) Beginning July 1, 2020, the fiscal year of the
2 government shall commence on the first day of July and end on
3 the thirtieth day of June. This fiscal year shall be used for
4 purposes of making appropriations and of financial reporting
5 and shall be uniformly adopted by all departments,
6 institutions, bureaus, boards, commissions and other state
7 agencies, county governments, and city and county boards of
8 education.

9 "§11-8-1.

10 "For the purposes of this chapter the fiscal year
11 shall begin ~~October 1~~ and shall end ~~September 30~~ following on
12 the dates as provided for state government in Section 1-3-4.

13 "§16-13-1.

14 "The fiscal year of every board of education shall
15 begin ~~October 1~~ and shall end September 30 on the dates as
16 provided for state government in Section 1-3-4.

17 "§11-43A-29.

18 "The fiscal year of the municipality shall begin ~~on~~
19 ~~the first day of each October in each year~~ and shall end ~~on~~
20 ~~the last day of each September~~ on the dates as provided for
21 state government in Section 1-3-4. Such fiscal year shall also
22 constitute the budget and accounting year. As used in this
23 article, the term "budget year" shall mean the fiscal year for
24 which any particular budget is adopted and in which it is
25 administered.

26 "The city manager, at least 45 days prior to the
27 beginning of each budget year, shall submit to the council a

1 budget proposal, with explanations. The council shall adopt a
2 budget, by ordinance, prior to the beginning of each fiscal
3 year. The budget so adopted shall be a public record and shall
4 be available for inspection by the general public. Any changes
5 in the budget, during the course of the budget year, shall be
6 done by ordinance.

7 "§11-43A-94.

8 "(a) The fiscal year of the municipality shall begin
9 ~~on the first day of each October in each year~~ and shall end ~~on~~
10 ~~the last day of September~~ on the dates as provided for state
11 government in Section 1-3-4. Such fiscal year shall also
12 constitute the budget and accounting year. As used in this
13 article, the term "budget year" shall mean the fiscal year for
14 which any particular budget is adopted and in which it is
15 administered.

16 "(b) The city manager, at least 45 days prior to the
17 beginning of each budget year, shall submit to the council a
18 budget proposal with explanations. The council shall adopt a
19 budget, by ordinance, prior to the beginning of each fiscal
20 year. The budget so adopted shall be a public record and shall
21 be available for inspection by the general public. Any changes
22 in the budget during the course of the budget year shall be
23 made by ordinance.

24 "§11-43C-41.

25 "The fiscal year of the city government shall ~~end on~~
26 ~~the last day of September of each calendar year~~ begin and
27 shall end on the dates as provided for state government in

1 Section 1-3-4. Such fiscal year shall also constitute the
2 budget and accounting year. As used in this chapter, the term
3 "budget year" shall mean the fiscal year for which any
4 particular budget is adopted and in which it is administered.

5 "§11-44C-41.

6 "The fiscal year of the city government shall ~~end on~~
7 ~~the last day of September of each calendar year~~ begin and
8 shall end on the dates as provided for state government in

9 Section 1-3-4. Such fiscal year shall also constitute the
10 budget and accounting year. As used in this chapter, the term
11 "budget year" shall mean the fiscal year for which any
12 particular budget is adopted and in which it is administered.

13 "§11-44E-110.

14 "The fiscal year of the city government shall begin
15 ~~on the first day of October~~ and shall end ~~on the last day of~~
16 ~~September of each calendar year~~ on the dates as provided for
17 state government in Section 1-3-4. Such fiscal year shall also
18 constitute the budget and accounting year. As used in this
19 chapter, the term "budget year" shall mean the fiscal year for
20 which any particular budget is adopted and in which it is
21 administered."

22 Section 2. The Governor of Alabama shall promulgate
23 procedures deemed necessary to affect the orderly
24 implementation of the change in the fiscal year as required by
25 this act.

26 Section 3. Fiscal year 2020, which begins October 1,
27 2019 shall, upon passage of this act, become a nine-month

1 implementation fiscal year which ends June 30, 2020. All
2 appropriations made for the term that is the current lawful
3 fiscal year 2020 shall be valid for the period October 1, 2019
4 through September 30, 2020, but shall be for the nine-month
5 implementation fiscal year and 25 percent of the
6 appropriations shall be for the first quarter (July 1 through
7 September 30, 2020) for the new fiscal year 2021.

8 Section 4. In those instances where the law provides
9 for a sum certain of tax revenue to be distributed in the
10 fiscal year, a total of 75 percent of such sum certain amounts
11 of tax revenue shall be distributed for the nine-month
12 implementation fiscal year only. Such sum certain amounts of
13 tax revenue shall be distributed as provided by law for the
14 new fiscal year 2021 and thereafter.

15 Section 5. All references made to the fiscal year of
16 the state within the Code of Alabama 1975 shall be restated to
17 conform to the newly adopted July 1 through June 30 fiscal
18 year, beginning with the fiscal year 2020.

19 Section 6. It is the intention of the act, in
20 changing the date of the fiscal year, to allow the same number
21 of advance days to all state agencies, departments, boards,
22 commissions, institutions, or districts to do any act required
23 of them by statute or regulation which was previously measured
24 by the October 1 fiscal year. Therefore any such agency,
25 department, board, commission, institution, or district is
26 authorized to compute time limitation requirements imposed on
27 them in accordance with the nine-month implementation fiscal

1 year and the new July 1 fiscal year whether or not such time
2 limitations are referred to in the Code of Alabama 1975, by a
3 specific date or by a set number of days.

4 Section 7. The Code Commissioner is directed to
5 replace all fiscal year begin and end date references in the
6 Code of Alabama 1975, to reflect the beginning date of the
7 first day of July and end with the thirtieth day of June,
8 inclusive, each year. No statute or resolution shall be deemed
9 invalid due to the change in fiscal year implemented under the
10 provisions of this act.

11 Section 8. This act shall become effective
12 immediately upon its passage and approval, by the Governor, or
13 on its otherwise becoming law.
