2.6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Any active and contributing member of 1 2 the Teachers' Retirement System, who has earned a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing and a Master of Arts in Health 3 Education, may claim and purchase credit in the system not to 4 5 exceed two years for prior service as a graduate assistant in the School of Education, Department of Curriculum and Instruction, at the University of Alabama at Birmingham between September 1, 1996, and November 30, 1997, supporting 8 an assigned faculty member of the school. The certification of 9 10 prior service claimed under this section shall conform to applicable administrative rules and procedures of the 11 Teachers' Retirement System. Members shall receive credit for 12 13 the prior service when they remit to the system the contributions required by subsection (b). No member shall 14 15 receive credit for any service that the member is already credited within the system or any other public retirement 16 plan, with the exception of the federal Social Security 17 18 program.

(b) Any member who is eligible to purchase service credit pursuant to subsection (a) shall pay to the Secretary-Treasurer of the system, within one year from the effective date of this act, for the claimed service, the full actuarially determined cost for each year of claimed service as determined by the system's actuary.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
