A thrift shop located on a military 5 installation in Alabama is exempted from the collecting or 6 7 paying of any state, county, and municipal sales and use 8 taxes. Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 9 10 first day of the third month following its passage and 11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
