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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, a veteran who qualifies
9 for a veteran distinctive license plate may apply
10 for and receive an appropriate veteran distinctive
11 license plate. The veteran is required to provide
12 the licensing official evidence of qualification
13 for an appropriate tag by a form DD214 or other
14 documentation prescribed by law or administrative
15 rule.

16 This bill would specify that a veteran could
17 provide proof for an appropriate tag by a
18 government issued identification card.

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24 To amend Act 2017-400 of the 2017 Regular Session,
25 now appearing as Section 32-6-250.1 of the Code of Alabama
26 1975, relating to military veteran distinctive license plates;

1 to specify that a veteran could provide proof for an
2 appropriate tag by a government issued identification card.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. Act 2017-400 of the 2017 Regular Session,
5 now appearing as Section 32-6-250.1 of the Code of Alabama
6 1975, is amended to read as follows:

7 "§32-6-250.1.

8 "An applicant for a veteran distinctive license
9 plate shall be a veteran of the appropriate conflict or
10 otherwise qualify for the distinctive license plate as
11 authorized by this chapter. Notwithstanding subsection (d) of
12 Section 32-6-350, the applicant shall provide the licensing
13 official with form DD214, a government issued identification
14 card showing appropriate veteran status for the appropriate
15 license plate, or any other documentation prescribed by law or
16 administrative rule as evidence of qualification for the
17 license plate. In the event that form DD214 or other
18 qualifying documentation prescribed by law or administrative
19 rule is unavailable, the applicant shall provide the licensing
20 official with a certification of eligibility from the
21 Department of Veterans' Affairs after the applicant provides
22 that office with other authoritative documentation evidencing
23 eligibility for the license plate."

24 Section 2. This act shall become effective
25 immediately following its passage and approval by the
26 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
