PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Legislature may arrange this constitution, as 4 5 amended, in proper articles, parts, and sections, omitting all 6 sections, clauses, and words not in force and making no other 7 changes in the provisions or language thereof, during the 2022 8 Regular Session of the Legislature. The draft and arrangement, when approved by a three-fifths vote of each house of the 9 10 Legislature, through joint resolution, shall be submitted to the voters pursuant to Amendment 714 of the Constitution of 11 12 Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 286.01 of the 13 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. The Constitution of Alabama, with the amendments 14 15 made thereto, in accordance with this amendment, once approved 16 by the voters, shall be the supreme law of the state.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

23 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 24 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 25 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 26 following description of the substance or subject matter of 27 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 1 2 Alabama of 1901, to authorize the Legislature to recompile the Alabama Constitution and submit it during the 2022 Regular 3 4 Session, and provide a process for its ratification by the voters of this state. 5 "Proposed by Act ." 6 This description shall be followed by the following 7 8 language: "Yes () No ()." 9
