12 Mr. Vick Eugene Calhoun, on February 3, 2018, and we uplift  
13 his inspiring life and legacy with utmost reverence and  
14 respect; and

15 WHEREAS, the passing of Mr. Vick Eugene Calhoun  
16 leaves a void in the lives of his loving family, many friends,  
17 and the entire community, where he was highly regarded; and

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Vick Eugene Calhoun was born April 16,  
19 1938, in Newnan, Georgia; he graduated from Cobb Avenue High  
20 School, where he helped lead the Panthers to many state  
21 championships; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Calhoun was married to his beloved and  
23 devoted wife for 53 years and was blessed with beautiful  
24 children and grandchildren; he retired from the Anniston Army  
25 Depot with 30 years of service and provided over 30 years of  
26 loyal and dedicated service to the Calhoun County Civil  
27 Service Board; and

1           WHEREAS, Mr. Calhoun was a member of the Alabama  
2 Democratic Conference, Thomas A. Williams Elk Lodge 1668, and  
3 Choccolocco Heritage Society; he served as a member of the  
4 Trustee Board of Mt. Calvary Baptist Church and of New  
5 Prospect Baptist Church; through the years, he earned  
6 widespread admiration and respect for his tireless dedication  
7 and exceptional abilities; and

8           WHEREAS, in poems to comfort and thoughts to  
9 encourage, the words of John Wesley describes the life of Vick  
10 Eugene Calhoun; "Do all the good you can, by all the means you  
11 can, in all the ways you can, in all the places you can, at  
12 all the times you can, to all the people you can, as long as  
13 ever you can"; and

14           WHEREAS, Mr. Vick Eugene Calhoun was a valued member  
15 of the community; although his presence is greatly missed, his  
16 memory is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who
