5           reminder that the Scout should do his best everyday; and the  
6           Arrow of Light Patch is worn on the Boy Scout uniform below  
7           the left pocket close to the heart and serves as one of only  
8           two achievements from one's youth that is displayed on the  
9           uniform as an adult besides the Eagle Scout rank; and

11           requirements in order to earn the coveted Arrow of Light Award  
12           including fellowship and duty to God, first aid, safe outdoor  
13           cooking, physical fitness and good health, transformation into
