fired four times through his windshield and into the rear window of the truck, each shot narrowly missing his attacker; he was able to successfully end the assault; and

WHEREAS, rather than request medics for himself, Officer Garlen, having obtained control of the offender, requested medics respond to evaluate a fellow officer to ensure he had not been injured during the pursuit or from the discharge of his weapon; it was not until after the other officer had received medical attention that Officer Garlen advised he had been injured; and

11 WHEREAS, Officer Garlen demonstrated courageous, 12 calm, and intelligent quick thinking; he took action to defend 13 his life and reduce the danger to the lives of fellow officers 14 involved in the pursuit as well as innocent citizens, and he 15 is truly deserving of this distinguished nomination for the 16 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement; now therefore,
