WHEREAS, determined as ever to overcome the effects of her stroke, Denver worked diligently in therapy and in careful coordination with her doctors and by the beginning of the next school year she was able to return full-time to school; by her senior year she was not only playing volleyball, basketball, and softball, but was the captain of the cheerleading squad and the varsity volleyball and softball teams, as well as president of the student council and her school's chapter of the Fellowship for Christian Athletes; academically she has risen to the occasion and is ranked 6th in her senior class of 50 students; and

WHEREAS, Denver's will to live and determination to overcome her obstacles in such extraordinary circumstances have been inspiring to all of those who know Denver; she plans to attend college and pursue a career as a neonatal nurse; and

WHEREAS, a worthy role model for countless young
Alabamians, Denver espouses the meritorious characteristics of

the Young Heroes Program, and she is truly deserving of
