colleague, Representative David Faulkner of Jefferson County,
is an active member of this commission; and

WHEREAS, among the duties of the Alabama Holocaust Commission is the responsibility to enhance public awareness of the consequences and significance of the Holocaust; the enabling act of the Commission states that it is the policy of the State of Alabama that Holocaust education is the proper concern of all peoples; and

9 WHEREAS, events such as the 2018 Yom HaShoah 10 Commemoration are consistent with the mission of the Alabama 11 Holocaust Commission providing Holocaust education and 12 focusing on citizen involvement in this commemoration; now 13 therefore,
