14	WHEREAS, the expungement law provides an avenue for
15	people to have their criminal records expunged under certain
16	circumstances; and
17	WHEREAS, we further recognize that people who have
18	been accused of committing crimes where there has been an
19	unequivocal judicial finding on the record that the arrest had
20	no foundation in probable cause, must incur expenses to have
21	their criminal records expunged; and
22	WHEREAS, under existing Alabama law, people must
23	file an expungement petition for each charge that they want
24	expunged; and
25	WHEREAS, under existing Alabama law, people must pay
26	\$300 per expungement petition, \$25 for a certified criminal

history record, and fees for fingerprinting, which can vary across local law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, people who have been accused of committing crimes where there has been an unequivocal judicial finding on the record that the arrest had no foundation in probable cause should not have to endure a financial hardship associated with having their criminal records expunged; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, That the Alabama State Legislature
is urged to amend Alabama's expungement law to eliminate fees
for people who have been accused of committing crimes where
there has been an unequivocal judicial finding on the record
that the arrest had no foundation in probable cause.
