8 MOURNING THE DEATH OF MARJORIE MCKINNON HALE.

10 WHEREAS, it is with profound sorrow that we note the  
11 death of Marjorie McKinnon Hale, on March 20, 2018, at the age  
12 of 95 years; and

13 WHEREAS, she was born in Auburn, Alabama, on May 23,  
14 1922, to Gladys and John Curtis McKinnon; she was a graduate  
15 of Alabama Polytechnic Institute (Auburn University) with a  
16 degree in Laboratory Technology; in 1943, she worked as a lab  
17 technician at Baptist Memorial Hospital in Gadsden; after  
18 starting a family, she retired and became a full-time  
19 homemaker; she lived in Gadsden over 60 years before moving to  
20 Atlanta to be near her family; and

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Hale was very active in Gadsden First  
22 Baptist Church, teaching Sunday School and Vacation Bible  
23 School, sewing costumes for Christmas plays and Easter  
24 pageants, singing in the Senior Choir, and participating in  
25 the Women's Missionary Union as well as the ladies' exercise  
26 class; and she was very proud that all four of her children  
27 were graduates of Auburn University; and

1           WHEREAS, she volunteered her time in the community  
2 by serving in leadership roles in the Gadsden Music Club,  
3 Woman's Club, the PTA, the American Association of University  
4 Women, and the Edenwood Garden Club; she also volunteered with  
5 the Lions Club by checking the vision of elementary school  
6 children; her grandchildren and great-grandchildren brought  
7 her the greatest joy; and

8           WHEREAS, Mrs. Hale was predeceased by her husband,  
9 Ben F. Hale; son, David Hale; brother, Jack McKinnon; and her  
10 parents; survivors include her children, Anne (Wilson) Craft,  
11 Ben (Crissie) Hale, and Mary (Bill) Schroth; grandchildren,  
12 David (Kelley) Schroth, Michael (Mallory) Schroth, and Lee  
13 (Jen) Craft, Justine (Nikola) Milosev, Trey Hale, Lindsey  
14 Craft, and McKinnon Hale; and numerous great-grandchildren;
