NAMING A PORTION OF US HIGHWAY 72 AT MILE MARKER 18
TO THE ALABAMA/MISSISSIPPI STATE LINE THE FRANKIE LEE WALLACE
HIGHWAY.

7 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Frankie Lee Wallace, of 8 Cherokee, Alabama, while serving in Vietnam, was leading a 9 patrol on a routine search of several villages when his squad 10 was suddenly engaged by small arms and automatic weapons fire 11 from a Viet Cong squad; and

12 WHEREAS, upon encountering hostile fire, First
13 Lieutenant Wallace led an assault on the positions
14 successfully forcing the Viet Cong to withdraw; and

WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace then led pursuit of the retreating Viet Cong until the insurgent force joined with a well-entrenched platoon size force; and

18 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace then directed 19 effective artillery fire and air strikes on the Viet Cong 20 platoon's positions; and

21 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace then led another 22 assault and was met by intense automatic weapons and mortar 23 fire, forcing him to withdraw; and

24 WHEREAS, during the withdrawal, a member of 25 Wallace's squad fell wounded, and, Wallace, without HJR13

hesitation, ran into an open rice paddy to aid his wounded

2 comrade, receiving a wound to the leg before reaching him; and WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace, unmindful of his 3 wound, continued to approach the stricken solider, killing two 4 5 Viet Cong who were also attempting to reach the wounded man; 6 and WHEREAS, despite being fully exposed to intense Viet 7 Cong fire concentrated upon him, First Lieutenant Wallace 8 9 provided aid to the wounded solider and attempted to assist 10 him to safety, receiving a mortal wound by hostile automatic 11 weapons fire while doing so; and 12 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace's leadership, 13 courage, and inspiring example were instrumental in saving the 14 life of the injured soldier; and 15 WHEREAS, First Lieutenant Wallace was posthumously 16 awarded the Silver Star for his leadership and unimpeachable 17 valor displayed against a numerically superior hostile force, 18 reflecting great credit upon himself, his unit, and the United States Army; now therefore, 19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 20 21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby designate the 22 section of US Highway 72 beginning at Mile Marker 18 and 23 continuing West to the Alabama/Mississippi State Line as the 24 "Frankie Lee Wallace Highway" in honor and memory of First

25 Lieutenant Frankie Lee Wallace.
