3 RECOGNIZING NICOLE CARRUTH FOR HER ATHLETIC
4 ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

6 WHEREAS, highest commendations are herein proudly
7 presented to Nicole Carruth for her athletic accomplishments;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the highly accomplished daughter of Freddie
10 and Alice Ann Carruth, Nicole Carruth has accumulated an
11 extensive record of excellence; and

12 WHEREAS, highlights from her Sulligent High School
13 Basketball career include being named "Miss Basketball" for
14 the State of Alabama, receiving selection as Honorable Mention
15 All-America and 3-A Player of the Year, scoring a total of
16 3,494 points from seventh to twelfth grades, obtaining a
17 regional scoring record with 81 points vs. St. Paul's in two
18 games, scoring 48 points against St. Paul's in the 1996
19 regionals, leading Sulligent to the 3-A State Championship in
20 1996 and three straight Final Four appearances, selection as a
21 3-A Tournament MVP and County and Area Tournament MVP,
22 selection as a three-time all state and an all-state
23 tournament team member, being a three point force, scoring 250
24 career treys, averaging 41 points in the 1995 state playoffs,
25 playing point guard at Sulligent, averaging 28.9 points as a

1 senior, making the Tuscaloosa News Girls Super 5 Team and the
2 Birmingham News Super All-State teams, and being an all-county
3 and all-area softball player; and

4 WHEREAS, during her basketball career at The
5 University of Alabama, she ranked first in career 3-point
6 field goal percentage, ranked ninth in career 3-point field
7 goals made, ranked 7th in 3-point field goals made in a game
8 at The University of Alabama, ranked fifth in three-point
9 field goal percentage in a game at The University of Alabama,
10 played in 110 games, and averaged 6.7 points, 1.1 rebounds,
11 and 1.0 assists; and

12 WHEREAS, Nicole Carruth currently resides in
13 Sulligent with her husband, Shay Taylor, and they have three
14 children, Kenyon, Kynlee, and Kallie; the esteemed couple
15 works with the children's basketball program; Nicole Carruth
16 also contributes exceptional direction as an assistant coach
17 for the Sulligent High School Lady Blue Devils; and

18 WHEREAS, through the years, Nicole Carruth has
19 earned widespread admiration and respect, and she is truly
20 deserving of special commendation and praise; now therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
22 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Nicole Carruth is highly
23 honored and commended, and this resolution is offered to her
24 in highest tribute, as well as with sincere best wishes for
