7 Humanity, the Jefferson County Department of Human Resources
8 Quality Assurance Committee, and the Greater Birmingham Young
9 Republicans; he is a member of the Birmingham Tip-Off Club,
10 and the Monday Morning Quarterback Club; and

11 WHEREAS, Representative Williams is a member of
12 Fullness Christian Fellowship and has two sons, Regan and
13 Jordan; and

14 WHEREAS, Representative Williams has worked
15 tirelessly on behalf of the citizens of Alabama while serving
16 in the House of Representatives and all who have served with
17 him will always remember his dedication and inspiring service;
