7 Red Marlow who was in the final four on season 13 of the
8 popular television show, "The Voice"; and

9 WHEREAS, Marlow, a native of Rogersville, Alabama,
10 has a love of skeet shooting, fishing, hunting, and music; and

11 WHEREAS, his father was a preacher, so growing up he
12 was exposed to a lot of Bluegrass and Southern Gospel; at the
13 age of 22, he moved to Nashville to further his music career
14 and became a demo singer, singing songs for songwriters for
15 about 15 years; and

16 WHEREAS, in order to support his family, Red started
17 his own construction company called "Mr. Fix All, and though
18 he enjoys it, "The Voice" has given him one last chance to see
19 if he can make music his full-time job; and

20 WHEREAS, from the age of 9, Red sang and played
21 music in church; his father would go preach, and he and his
22 siblings provided the music; and

23 WHEREAS, his unique, hooky mixture of contemporary
24 and traditional country styles creates a signature vocal sound
25 that defines him as an artist; and

1 WHEREAS, Red credits songwriter, Phillip White for
2 inspiring him to move to Nashville; White, who is also from
3 Alabama, wrote "I'm Moving On" for Rascal Flatts and "Nobody
4 But Me" for Blake Shelton; and

5 WHEREAS, Marlow released his debut, a self titled
6 album produced by Phillip White; the album includes the single
7 "Whatcha Think About That", which was featured on Sirius XM
8 The Highway; and

9 WHEREAS, Red Marlow appeared on season 13 of the
10 popular show "The Voice" in 2017; he was named by the judges
11 Adam Levine, Blake Shelton, Miley Cyrus, and Jennifer Hudson,
12 as one of the strongest contestants on the show; and

13 WHEREAS, Red Marlow is a brilliant singer, his
14 fourth place finish opens the doors for greater opportunities
15 for him as a successful singer, song writer, and performer;
16 now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
18 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That Red Marlow is highly honored
19 and commended as a talented musician, songwriter, and
20 performer, and this resolution is offered to him in highest
21 tribute, along with congratulations and sincere best wishes in
