18	Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the	
19	Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State	
20	Pilotage Commission until October 1, 2020, with the additional	
21	recommendation for statutory change as set out in Section 3.	
22	Section 2. The existence and functioning of the	
23	State Pilotage Commission, created and functioning pursuant to	
24	Sections 33-4-1 to 33-4-57, inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975,	
25	is continued until October 1, 2020, and those code sections	
26	are expressly preserved.	

Section 3. Section 33-4-1 of the Code of Alabama 2 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"There shall be a board of pilotage commissioners, to be known as the State Pilotage Commission, which shall consist of three four members, one to be an official of a steamship company which maintains an office in Mobile, one to be an active bar pilot, licensed and branched by such State Pilotage Commission, and one to be a business man or in a professional occupation licensed by the State of Alabama, and one to be a retiree from active duty in the Navy or the Coast Guard of the United States, or any reserve or National Guard component thereof, or to have extensive experience in the maritime industry, excluding experience working with a steamboat company or as a bar pilot. The membership of the commission shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. Such State Pilotage Commission shall have such powers and duties as are prescribed in this chapter and as may hereafter be prescribed by law."

Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in Sections 1, 2, and 3.

Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
