| 21 | Section 1. The following new section is added to the |
| 22 | Code of Alabama, 1975 to read as follows: |
| 23 | § 40-7-25.4 |
| 24 | (a) The governing body of a county may, in its |
| 25 | discretion, grant an abatement of all or a portion of the |
| 26 | taxes otherwise due under Section 40-7-25.3 with respect to |
| 27 | property located within the county. |

(b) The abatement provided by subsection (a) may
 only be granted if all of the following are satisfied:

3 (1) The property will be used for a qualifying
4 project as defined in Section 40-18-372 (1);

5 (2) The qualifying project shall create at least the 6 number of new jobs specified in Section 40-18-372 (2);

7 (3) The property is an area within which not less than one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) of capital 8 9 expenditures in connection with the establishment, expansion, 10 construction, equipping, development, or rehabilitation of such qualifying project is anticipated to be made based upon 11 representations and information provided by the anticipated 12 13 user or users of the qualifying project and such other 14 information as the county shall have available to it and deems 15 appropriate; and

16 (4) If the property is located within a
17 municipality, the abatement shall be consented to by
18 resolution of the governing body of such municipality.

(c) The abatement granted by a county pursuant to 19 20 this section shall be embodied in an agreement between the 21 county and the owner or user of the property. The agreement 22 described in the preceding sentence shall be filed with the Department of Revenue within 90 days after the granting of the 23 24 abatement, the contents of which the Department of Revenue 25 shall use solely for its statistical and recordkeeping activities but shall otherwise keep confidential unless 26 27 consented to in writing by the owner or user of the property.

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Section 2. The provisions of this act are severable.
 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
 unconstitutional, the declaration shall not affect the part
 which remains.

5 Section 3. This act shall become effective 6 immediately following its passage and approval by the 7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
