8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Governor may make a 9 temporary appointment to the office of United 10 States Senator upon a vacancy in the office until a 11 successor is elected and qualified.

12 Also under existing law, whenever a vacancy 13 occurs in the office of United States Senator less 14 than four months but more than 60 days before a 15 general election, the vacancy is filled at that 16 election. If the vacancy occurs more than four 17 months or less than 60 days before a general 18 election, the Governor is required to call a 19 special election.

This bill would eliminate the authority of the Governor to appoint a person to a vacancy in the office of United States Senator and would provide that, upon a vacancy in the office, the Governor must set an election to fill the vacancy to be held within 120 days of the vacancy.

13	Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of senator
14	of and from the State of Alabama in the Senate of the United
15	States more than four months before a general election, the
16	Governor of Alabama shall forthwith order an election to be
17	held by the qualified electors of the state to elect a senator
18	of and from the State of Alabama to the United States Senate
19	for the unexpired term. If the vacancy occurs within four
20	months of but more than 60 days before a general election, the
21	vacancy shall be filled at that election. If the vacancy
22	occurs within 60 days before a general election, the Governor
23	shall order a special election to be held on the first Tuesday
24	after the lapse of 60 days from and after the day on which the
25	vacancy is known to the Governor, and the senator elected at
26	such special election shall hold office for the unexpired
27	term, the successor shall be elected for the unexpired term at

1	the next general election, if the general election will occur
2	within 120 days of the vacancy. If the next general election
3	will not be held within 120 days of the vacancy, the Governor
4	shall set a special election for the election of a successor
5	for the unexpired term, to be held within 120 days of the
6	vacancy.
7	Section 2. Section 36-9-7 of the Code of Alabama
8	1975, is repealed.
9	Section 3. This act shall become effective
10	immediately following its passage and approval by the
11	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
