12		Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama

18		becoming effective with regard to a local

22		affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates

25		The purpose or effect of this bill would be

funds within the meaning of the amendment. However,

1 (2) Any person who violates a rule adopted pursuant 2 to this act shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor and shall 3 be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than five 4 hundred dollars (\$500) for each offense, and may be required 5 to pay all costs of the proceedings.

- (3) When collected, all fines shall be paid to the Office of the State Forester to be delivered to the State Treasurer and placed in the Alabama Forestry Commission Fund.
- (b) The State Forester and any employee of the State Forestry Commission so designated by the State Forester shall have and is vested with the authority to defer charges and issue a citation against a person for violating a rule adopted pursuant to this act or for the violation of any other provision of this article.

Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
